Individual Placement Description – The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust

Placement	FY2 - Emergency Medicine
The department	The Emergency Department (ED) is located at Russells Hall Hospital and is a 24/7 service. This is the major ED in the area and serves the population of Dudley and surrounding areas.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>The trainee will be a full member of the ED workforce at DGH, comprising 4 FY2s, 9GPVTS, 4 CT1s, 11 Trust Grade junior doctors, 10 Advanced Care Practitioners, 3 Physician Associates, 4 registrars ST4+, 3 Junior Middle Grades ST3, 11 Trust ED middle-grades and 18 Consultants.</p> <p>There is a full induction programme. Each FY2 has a designated consultant supervisor/mentor.</p> <p>There is a formal 3 hour clinical teaching programme for all FY2s every Tuesday afternoon and additional ED teaching on Friday mornings. Junior doctors are fully supported with shop-floor consultant supervision 0800 to 2400h 365 days and middle-grade supervision outside these hours.</p>

Supervisor(s) for the placement	Named supervisors are appointed in line with the GMC requirements for Clinical and Educational Supervision and will be allocated at the time of appointment
Main duties of the placement	<p>During the Emergency Medicine placement, the FY2 doctor gains extensive clinical experience across all aspects of emergency care. The role involves assessing and managing undifferentiated patients presenting with a wide range of acute medical, surgical, and trauma-related conditions. FY2 doctors are expected to develop the skills necessary to prioritise and manage patients safely in a high-pressure, fast-paced environment. This includes initiating investigations, formulating differential diagnoses, and implementing initial management plans under supervision.</p> <p>Throughout the placement, FY2 doctors are supported by consultants who are present in the department for 16 hours a day and by senior registrars who provide supervision and guidance 24/7. This structured support ensures a safe learning environment while allowing FY2 doctors to build confidence and clinical competence. The placement also encourages active participation in multidisciplinary teamwork and fosters development in communication, decision-making, and procedural skills essential for emergency care</p>
